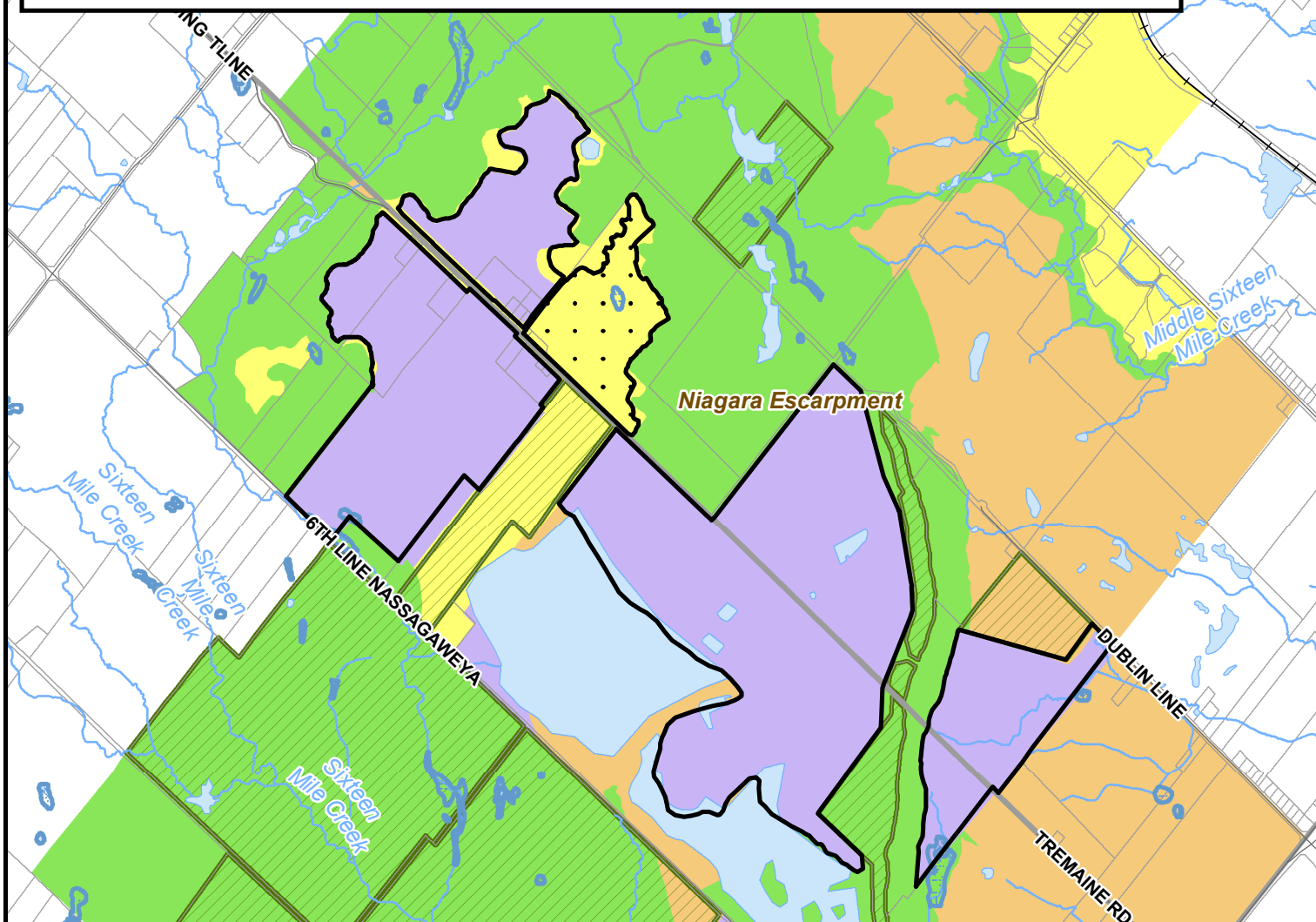


- 1) To amend the Niagara Escarpment Plan (NEP) to redesignate 30.6 ha (75.6 ac) of lands described as Part Lots 11, 12 & 13 Concession 1 (former geographic Township of Esquesing), Town of Halton Hills, Region of Halton from Escarpment Rural Area to Mineral Resource Extraction Area.
- 2) To apply a special policy under the NEP Part 1.9.3 (Permitted Uses) that applies to the subject properties described as Part Lots 8-10, 13 and 14, Concession 1 (former geographic Township of Esquesing), Town of Hilton Hills, Region of Halton and Part of Lots 8-14, Concession 7 (former geographic Township of Nassagaweya), Town of Milton Region of Halton, that would permit the continued use of an office and maintenance buildings, facilities for washing, processing and stockpiling of aggregate, truck washing facility, recycling facilities and the entrance, for the purpose of supporting the extraction of aggregate on the lands proposed to be re-designated to Mineral Resource Extraction Area, and only while the two sites are actively operated by a single licensee, as an integrated operation.

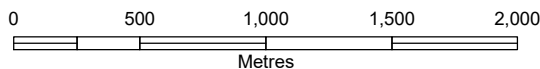
